When are students allowed to use their electronic devices?

School Bus	YES	With earbuds or headphones unless directed otherwise by bus driver.
Before 1 st Bell	YES	With earbuds or headphones. Once the first bell rings, you must turn off your device and store it out of sight.
Classroom	NO	Unless directed by the teacher for instructional purposes. If used during class, students must turn device off and store out of sight before exiting the classroom.
Hallways/ between classes	NO	Visible earbuds/headphones will be confiscated
LUNCH	YES	Only permissible in the café during assigned lunch
Locker rooms	NO	
Special Events	NO	Unless otherwise directed. Special events include but are not limited to: pep rallies, assemblies, presentations, field trips.



- Devices/accessories need to be turned off and stored out of sight from the first bell until the dismissal bell.
- When allowed, devices can only be utilized in the vibrate or silent mode. Students are not allowed to charge their personal electronic devices at school.
- Students are strictly prohibited from taking photos or audio/video recordings.
- When allowed to use the devices, students are expected to adhere to the PWCS Acceptable Use Policy for Technology at ALL times. Any student found to be entering inappropriate sites shall be considered in violation.
- GFHS is not responsible for the loss, theft, or damage to any student's personal devices or accessories. Student who chose to bring an electronic device to school do so at their own risk.

Consequences: Devices and accessories will be confiscated by security and given to the student's Alpha Administrator. Students who repeatedly violate these procedures will be subjected to more stringent disciplinary action.
